






International Tournament Ski will be on your right (2.5 Miles)

Regular sessions are Monday through Friday; the two-day weekend session begins Saturday. Private lessons with Jack Travers or one of his staff are also available. All sessions







may be arranged with or without room and board, if space is available. Sunset Lakes is located on 110 acres surrounded by rolling hills and live oak. The site consists of three man-made lakes with slalom and jump courses and the best three-event coaching and driving available. All boats are equipped with Zero-Off speed control. On-site accommodations include air conditioned/heated cabins equipped with TV's game room, and private seating areas as well as a full circuit gym.

An overnight stay includes three meals, served in a casual family style atmosphere. The menu includes an abundance of fruits, salads, breads, vegetables, and desserts, along with a healthy entree.
